This gala includes 50m, 100m and 200m events in all four strokes as well as 100m and 200m Individual Medley. Don't worry if you haven't got times for an event, we will work these out for you – just let us know which events you want to enter and we will do the rest! Faster swimmers will need to make sure they are eligible to enter by checking cut off times for each event. An entry form will be circulated by email shortly. Closing date for entries is Thursday 20th June at 7pm.

Blackpool Rocks Swimming Gala Results

Garstang swimmers made the short journey to Blackpool to compete in this year's Annual Blackpool Rocks open meet. **Eloise Barber** and **Rachel Williamson** got the squad's challenge under way in the 400 Freestyle where both produced magnificent efforts. Off the blocks they quickly found their rhythm and held themselves together brilliantly, with **Eloise** lowering her previous best by 7 seconds and taking 7th place, whilst Rachel lowered her P.B. by a clear 8 seconds. **Eloise** then moved on to give an outstanding display of her all round skills by competing in six events over the weekend and producing results to be proud of. Her best results came from the Individual Medleys with some awesome swimming where her Breaststroke ability put her into 5th place in 100m Individual Medley and 7th place in the 200m in which she secured an impressive County Time to add to her tally. Another 7th place came from her 100m Breaststroke where her stroke pattern, coupled with superb turns and transitions put her up amongst the big guns. **Rachel** although outside the medals, went on to give some fine performances taking part in no less than 8 events.

Lucas Brown joined the action in the 50m Freestyle sprint where he came out of transition and took it on. Staying completely composed he drove into his turn and transition and then moved up a gear and put all his exertions into the final length. Into the pressure zone it was neck and neck and in a storming finish **Lucas** secured a silver medal. Another outstanding effort in the 50m Butterfly saw him getting closer to that elusive 30 second time with a brilliant 30.26 and a 6th place. He went on to take a highly commendable 7th place for his 100m Butterfly and an 8th place for the 100 Freestyle.

9 year old **Sophie Pinder** got a steady start with a good solid swim in the 50m Backstroke and then upped her game at Breaststroke, getting a brilliant start off the block to get into the mix in both 50m and 100m. Holding her nerve she produced fantastic P.B.s and a 6th and 8th place in these two events. **Erin McNeil** also shone in the breaststroke events. The 50m sprint gave her a P.B. whilst her 1:27.90 for the 100m brought her inside the County Qualifying Times.





Charlotte Wilson, another multiple competitor gave a super display, entering a total of seven events putting her all round ability to great use, with satisfying results. Penny Diggins another 12yr old also gave a good account of herself with performances well up to her highest standard. Jessica Critchley took on the sprints and using all her skill and power launched brilliant attacks in both the 50m Freestyle and Butterfly. Digging deep into her reserves she timed her finishes to perfection taking 5th and 6th places. These performances were fully supported by more remarkable swims from youngsters Isobel Critchley, Isaac Barber and Holly Diggins all of whom enjoyed a superb weekend for the Club.
